Programs

HALFWAY HOUSE

The halfway house program provides services to adult men who aim to recover their lives from drug and alcohol-related issues. Within a supportive and substance-free environment, the program assists men to integrate into the workforce, develop healthy relationships, strengthen their sober support networks and adaptively cope with life stressors. Treatment goals are collaboratively developed and individualized to each person's strengths, desires and needs.

TOUCHSTONE

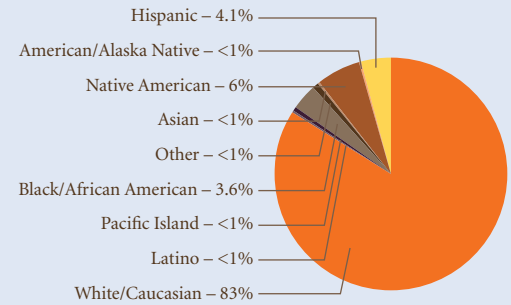
Touchstone served a larger number this fiscal year—up to 198 individuals from 157 in the past period. We served 25 IV drug users and 57 Mental Health board commitments. This is a higher number than past years. Touchstone had an excellent year for completions of treatment at 78% or 122 clients. This demonstrates improvements in client engagement and retention. This was impacted by our individualized treatment services while in programming.

TASC

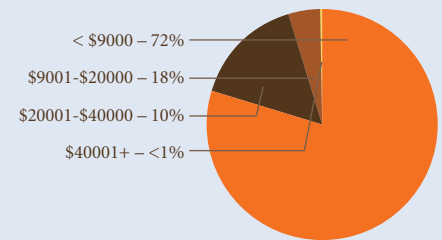
The TASC Program continues to evolve to meet the needs of consumers and our community's emergency behavioral health system. TASC programs have maintained a consistent case load. Consumers are requiring higher levels of care. The crisis response teams have been consistent and diverted 81% of all crisis calls responded to. TASC has a compassionate staff that makes a difference in consumer's lives each and every day.

Client Demographics

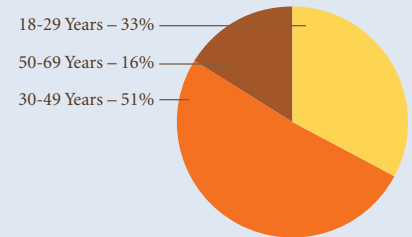
RACE / ETHNICITY



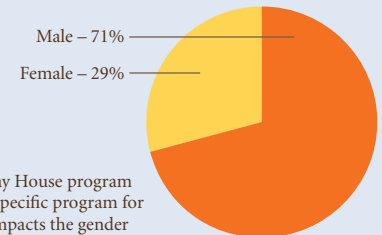
INCOME for year prior to treatment

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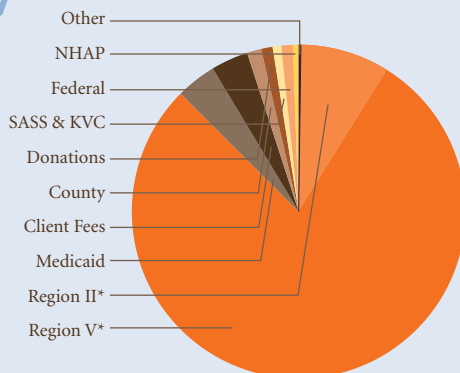
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Agency Revenue
