### Mission Statement

Houses of Hope provides affordable residential treatment and support services for individuals in recovery from substance use and related mental health issues.

### Agency Highlights

After 40 years of service to Houses of Hope, Jay Conrad retired as the Executive Director.

CARF re-accreditation through June of 2024 for all three programs of Halfway House, Touchstone, and TASC Programs. Most individuals in our care are eligible for Medicaid after Medicaid Expansion.

Continued to follow all COVID precautions necessary to protect staff and individuals in need of our care.

### Halfway House

A safe environment for individuals to take steps to move forward with their recovery, and return to independence within the community.
